About CEST2013

The International Conference on Environmental Science and Technology is one of the worldwide leading environmental conferences. This biennial conference brings together engineers, scientists, researchers, students, managers and other professionals in order to address and discuss emerging environmental issues. It is supported by the multi-disciplinary Global NEST (Network of Environmental Science and Technology); an international scientific movement focused on innovative environmental issues, which has been successfully developing for the last 24 years with members from more than 60 countries. The success of CEST reflects the critical environmental topics that are discussed as well as the quality of the presented papers. The 13th International Conference on Environmental Science and Technology (CEST2013) will be organized in Athens from 5 - 7 of September 2013.

Final Programme

CEST2013 Scientific Programme includes 35 sessions, running in 5 parallel rooms, with 312 oral and 158 poster presentations. The conference sessions cover 21 unique scientific topics.

Travel Information

How to get to the conference venue from Athens International Airport

- **by METRO**

Take Metro Line 3 (Blue line) from the Airport Terminal. Get off at EVANGELISMOS Station. The journey from Athens International Airport (Eleftherios Venizelos) to EVANGELISMOS station lasts about 38 minutes.

The Divani Caravel Hotel is approximately 5 minutes from the metro station on foot.



- **by BUS**

Take Bus Line X95 AIRPORT–SYNTAGMA (ATHENS EXPRESS) from the Airport Terminal. Get off at HILTON station. The Conference venue (Hotel Divani Caravel) is approximately 5 minutes from the bus stop on foot.

- **by TAXI**

The route from the Airport to the conference venue (Divani Caravel Hotel) takes about 45-50 minutes depending on the city traffic. The fare from the airport to Athens centre is fixed:

05:00am–24:00pm €35.00 (approx)

00:00pm–05:00am €50.00 (approx)

The price includes everything: luggage charge, tolls fee, VAT, meter start, airport charge. You don't have to pay anything more than the above. Still the taxi driver has to start the meter in case you decide to change destination and your drop-up point is not in Athens centre. The same fixed fares apply when you pick a taxi from Athens centre to go to the airport.
